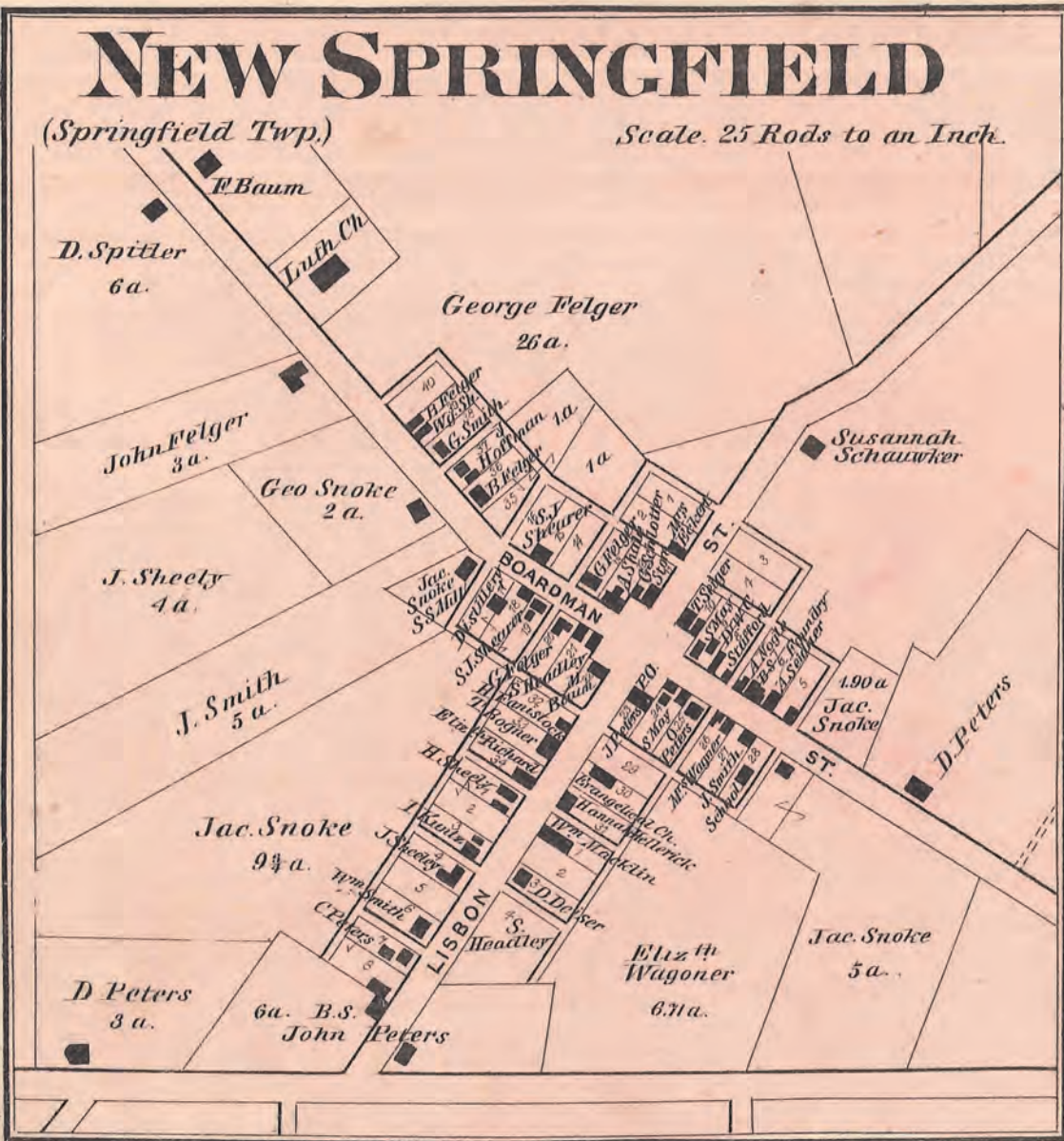

Scale 25 Rods to an Inch.

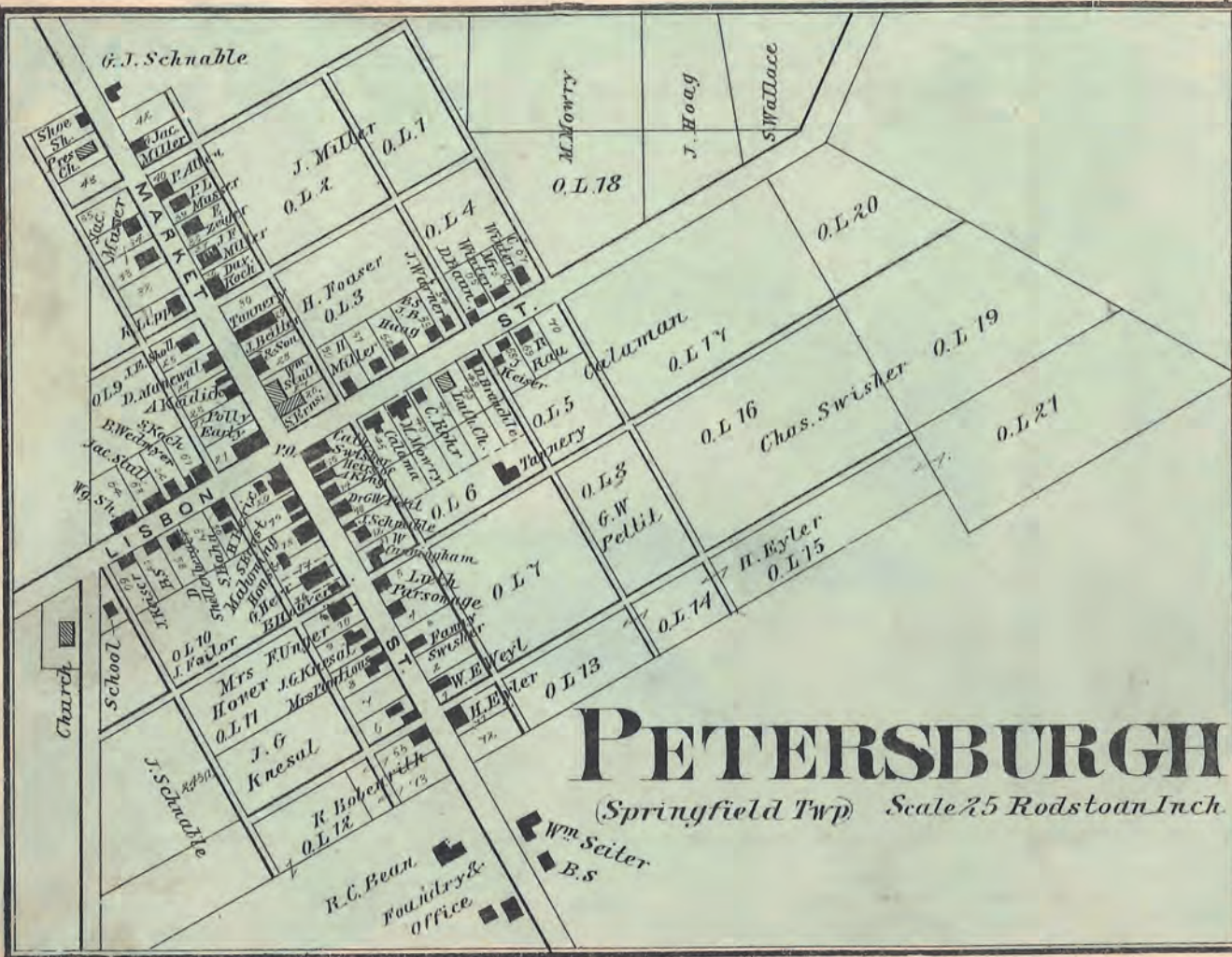
